The Chautauqua Clinic, centrally located on the grounds of Chautauqua Institution, offers urgent care and primary care services to residents and visitors of all ages. Staffed by a Physician Assistant under the direct supervision of Russell S. Elwell, MD, the clinic is an extension of AHN Westfield Memorial.

Simply ask your physician's office to mail or fax a copy of your medical records to our office. The Chautauqua Clinic has been treating residents and visitors since 1993 and serves nearly 1,000 patients each season.

AHN Westfield Memorial

AHN Westfield Memorial is a primary care hospital with 24/7 emergency services located approximately 10 miles from Chautauqua Institution.

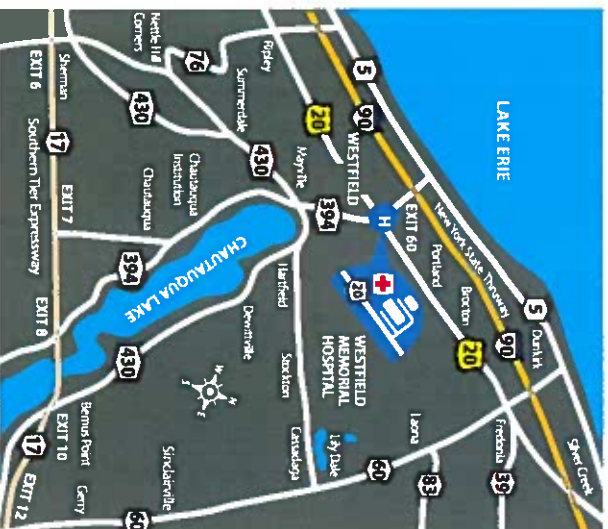
In addition to emergency patient care, the hospital offers a wide variety of diagnostic and outpatient services. Services include:

- 24/7 emergency care with ground and air transportation for trauma and health conditions requiring advanced care.
- Radiology services featuring X-ray, CT scan, digital mammography, ultrasound, fluoroscopy, and Dexa scan.
- Cardiac testing and rehabilitation including exercise and nuclear medicine stress testing, echocardiography, vascular studies, and personalized rehabilitation programs.
- Physical therapy professionals evaluate and treat patients with orthopaedic and neurological conditions, and provide education for self management.
- Lymphedema therapy services.
- Infusion services.
- Outpatient surgeries in ophthalmology, orthopaedics, and general surgery.
- Colonoscopy and endoscopy procedures.
- Diabetic self-management education and support program recognized by the American Diabetes Association and taught by a registered dietitian/certified diabetes educator. Insulin pump therapy and management is also available.
- Inpatient services.
